Fuji with augmented light projections; **Science on a Sphere**, a room-sized, six-foot diameter sphere, developed by NOAA as an educational tool to illustrate Earth system science; the three-story **Discovery House** with interactive exhibits; and more.

Experience the Harriet Tubman African American Museum

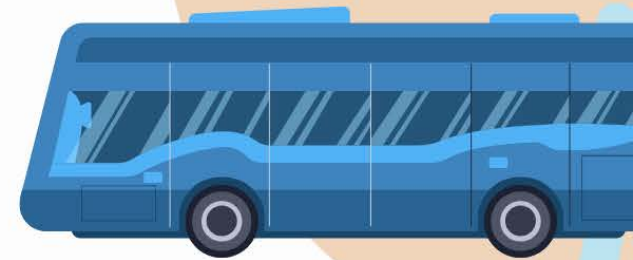
Discover the rich heritage and contributions of African American culture through dynamic exhibitions and cultural events. The carefully curated programs celebrate the arts, history and more.
